

The Third Workshop of the CIS Community of Practice in Curriculum Development: Inclusive Education: The Way of the Future. Minsk, October 29-31, 2007

The Workshop is organized by the National Institute of Education of Belarus Ministry of Education in cooperation with the IBE UNESCO (Geneva), UNESCO Office in Moscow and the CIS Council on Cooperation in Education (Minsk) as a continuation of the capacity building in curriculum development in the CIS region and also a preparatory activity to the 48th International Conference of Education (ICE) with the theme “Inclusive Education: The Way of the Future” that will be held in Geneva between the 25 and the 28 of November 2008 and participated by the national ministers of education from all the UNESCO regions.

The workshop will discuss a series of questions around inclusive education within a selected group of 25 CIS and UNESCO high-level educators and curriculum specialists. Participants will develop, present and discuss their countries’ reports on inclusive education, identify shared visions and concerns as well as good practices and experiences. They will clarify, prioritize and provide regional inputs to the formation of a regional roadmap on inclusive education.
